Look at these pictures. Put them in the correct order and tell the short story. Then answer the question: How do you think the family is feeling?

Back-up questions

What is the woman doing here? Where is she? Is she at the supermarket? What is she doing in the kitchen? What is in the bowl? What is she making? What are they doing here?

Part 3

Look, choose and answer. (Students choose 2 cards.)
